Where: National 4-H Youth Conference Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland

Who: 4-H members enrolled in grades 9-12 as of September 2019 who have an interest in politics, government, citizenship, civic engagement and/or presidential history are eligible to apply. Approximately 10 teens will be selected to represent New Jersey.

Program Overview: CWF – Presidential Inauguration 2021 is a 5-day event (Sunday-Thursday). Washington, D.C. will serve as a working classroom to provide the opportunity for program participants to learn about the Executive Branch of government; the democratic process; presidential history and the election process; citizenship and civic education; and to explore careers in politics.

Program Highlights – Delegates will:

- participate in workshops, sessions, and hear speakers
- visit memorials, historical sites, and museums
- practice their role in citizenship through service, civic education and engagement
- Experience Inauguration Day of our 46th President
- Attend social events including a unique Inaugural Ball dinner and dance cruise

Cost: \$1,625.00 per person which include all expenses - lodging, registration, tours and transportation. Delegates will receive a shirt, drawstring backpack, button, lanyard, cold weather accessories.
