

Mary & Fred Kossatz Awards for Scholarly Achievement in the New Jersey 4-H Horse Program



Two awards will be given.

Senior Division (Grades 9 - 13)

A \$150 US Savings Bond to the Senior 4-H'er who consistently participates in and portrays, a demonstration of achievement in the 4-H Horse Program Educational Activities.

Junior Division (Grades 4 - 8)

A \$100 US Savings Bond to the Junior 4-H'er who consistently participates in and portrays, a demonstration of achievement in the 4-H Horse Program Educational Activities.

Youth may only compete for this award once. However, a 4-H'er that won the Jr. Scholarship, when old enough, may move on and compete for the Sr. Scholarship.

These activities include but are not limited to:

- Horse Bowl
- Horse Judging
- Hippology
- Equine Presentations
- Equine Arts
- Teen Horse Council

The winner in each division is to be selected by a committee, made up of the Extension Equine Specialist, the Program Associate in 4-H Animal Science, and the 4-H HPAC Executive Committee. The award will be presented at the New Jersey State 4-H Championship Horse Show. Entries are due no later than August 11th.
