The New Jersey 4-H Equine Art Show Contest is open to any registered 4-H Member in grade K-13. Any type of art or craft may be entered but it must be equine themed.

## **RULES**

1. This event is open to ALL New Jersey 4-H club members (grades K-13.) Grade is determined by the grade the member is enrolled in as of September 2021.
2. Participates **DO NOT** need to be a member of the horse project area. **ALL** participants **MUST** be a registered 4-H club member as of **January 1, 2022.**
3. Contestants must be enrolled in a 4-H club for the current project year, in the county they are representing in the art show and be a “Member in Good Standing.”
4. Agent/staff **signature is REQUIRED** to ensure the member is in good standing. **NO signature= NO participation!**
5. Cloverbud exhibitors are grades K-3. Junior exhibitors are grades 4-8, and Senior exhibitors are grades 9-13.
  - a. Cloverbuds will receive participation ribbons and comments from the judges.
6. Each county is allowed to enter an unlimited number of exhibitors. Each exhibitor may enter up to 5 enters per type of item (i/e. 5 paintings, 5 colored drawings, 5 black and white drawings, 5 crafts, 5 colored photos, 5 black and white photos, etc.)
  - a. **ITEMS PREVIOUSLY ENTERED IN THE EQUINE ART CONTEST MAY NOT BE ENTERED AGAIN!**
7. All exhibitors must turn in original work and entries must follow a horse theme.
  - a. Photographs must be taken by the 4-H member submitting them.
  - b. Digital photography is welcome. Computer/digital edits are allowed but the member should list what was done to the photo (i/e. more cropping, contrast adjustments, etc.)
  - c. School art projects are accepted as long as they are horse themed.
8. Each item must be labeled with the following information: Name of 4-Her, County, Phone Number, Grade, Name/Title of the Artwork, Division (Cloverbud, Junior, Senior.)
  - a. **Each item must also have a score sheet with it.** The member must fill out the top portion.
9. Awards—1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded in each class. Rosettes or other awards will be given to the Best in Show in the Junior and Senior Divisions. .
  - a. **ANY ARTWORK NOT PICKED UP WILL NOT BE RETURNED!**
10. 4-Hers do NOT have to be present to participate in the art show. Entries may be brought and picked up by another person from their county.
  - a. Score sheets and information cards must be completed at the time of drop off.
