2021 New Jersey State 4-H Model Horse Show

WHEN: Saturday, Jan. 16, 2021

OPEN TO: 4-H members in good standing. Juniors are in 4th to 7th grade. Seniors are in 8th to 13th grade as of September 2020. *This is different than other State 4-H Equine Events.

WHERE: Virtually, using the Pony Bytes platform. Results will be posted as they are available throughout the day.

START TIME: Photos must be uploaded by 10 p.m. on Jan. 15, 2021. Judging will start around 9 a.m. Jan. 16, 2021.

ENTRIES: Due Jan. 13, 2021, Eligibility will be verified with your County 4-H office. Only registered 4-H members are eligible for this state 4-H contest. Once the entry has been received with payment, the entrant will get login information to upload photos. You **must provide an e-mail** that you check regularly. Early entry is encouraged.

ENTRY FEES: \$1.50 per model up to 19 horses; \$30 flat fee for 20 to 30 horses; \$40 for 31 or more models

CHECKS: Make checks payable to **Hunterdon 4-H Leaders Association**

SPONSORSHIPS: Each County should provide at least one sponsorship for \$20. This should be sent as a separate check from the entry fees and made payable to Hunterdon 4-H Leaders Association. Sponsorship information must be received by Jan. 10 to be included in the program.

CLASS LIMITS: Performance Classes: 2 entries per exhibitor; Halter Classes: 3 entries per exhibitor unless noted on class list

AWARDS: Flat ribbons to 10th place in each class, Rosettes to Champions and Reserves, Special Awards for High Point Exhibitors and Division, Championships. Awards will be mailed after the event. If you do not want to receive the flat ribbons check that off on the entry form.

NEW JERSEY STATE 4-H MODEL HORSE SHOW

OBJECTIVES — The primary objective of the 4-H Model Horse Project is an educational tool for teaching 4-H'ers about horses. Through the Model Horse Project, members learn about breeds, colors, gaits, tack and show ring activities. This project also allows members to use their artistic talents in the remaking of models, construction of tack and design and building backdrops.

The Model Horse Program also provides a venue for "horseless" club members to participate in a "horse show."

RULES AND REGULATIONS - MODEL SHOW

- 1. All counties are invited to enter all eligible exhibitors. Members must have been registered in their county 4-H program as of January 1 of the current year. Members must have an up to date horse or model horse record book. Members must have participated in 70% of their clubs' meetings in the past year. Members must have given or will give a 4-H presentation in the current 4-H year and have done a community service project.
- 2. Junior exhibitors are grade 4 7. Senior exhibitors are grades 8 13. Grade is determined by the grade in which the member is enrolled the September prior to the event. **NOTE THIS AGE BREAKDOWN IS DIFFERENT FROM OTHER STATE 4-H HORSE EVENTS.**
- 3. Entries will not be honored unless accompanied by appropriate entry fees in a check made payable to Hunterdon County 4-H Leaders Association. Bank returned checks will be assessed a \$25 fee.
- 4. Each participating county is responsible for a \$20 sponsorship. Additional sponsors are greatly appreciated. Sponsorships need to be received at least a week before the show.
- 5. Exhibitors will be assigned a number. In the photo information section include the horse's name, breed and any information you might provide on a card as it pertains to the entry.
- 6. A single model may show in more than one performance class. The same model may not cross enter in the junior and senior member divisions.

MEMO to Model Horse Show Participants:

To participate in the Virtual Model Horse Showing Webinar and the 2021 NJ State Model Horse Show you will need to prepare ahead of time. The sooner the better!

- 1. As soon as possible, members must go to https://www.ponybytes.com/ and sign up for an account. There is no charge and no obligation to participate in the future.
- 2. Send your user name to lrshupe@frontiernet.net so the admin can set your account to allow you to see the 4-H Shows.
- 3. Once your user account is set up you will get a link to the Dec. 28 Practice Show.(It may take a day or two)
- 4. For the Dec. 28 webinar you will be able to upload some photos starting Dec. 26 to three galleries: Halter, Performance, and Where Does My Horse Go? (for horses you are not sure what class they belong in). If you have technical difficulties, we can discuss that during the Zoom call.

For the State Model Horse Show on Jan. 16 once payment is received, your PonyBytes account will be set to allow you to enter the show. The sooner you enter, the sooner you can start uploading. Do not wait until the last minute as photos can take awhile to upload. You will have at least two weeks to upload.
